WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

The Emergency First Responder course is for:

- Certified divers preparing for the PADI Rescue Diver or Divemaster certification
- Travelers and adventurers who want to be prepared for emergencies
- Anyone who wants to feel confident and capable in helping others during accidents, injuries, or medical incidents

No prior experience is required, and you don't have to be a diver to take the course.





WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

Our EFR course covers both Primary Care (life-threatening situations) and Secondary Care (non-life-threatening injuries and illnesses).

THE TRAINING INCLUDES: PRIMARY CARE (CPR) SKILLS

- Scene safety assessment
- Barrier use (gloves, masks, etc.)
- Primary patient assessment
- CPR techniques (adult, child, and infant)
- Serious bleeding management
- Shock response
- Managing suspected spinal injuries
- Choking assistance (conscious and unconscious)

RECOMMENDED ADD-ON SKILLS

- Using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Administering emergency oxygen

SECONDARY CARE (FIRST AID) SKILLS

- Injury and illness evaluation
- Bandaging techniques
- Splinting dislocations and fractures



YOU'LL ALSO LEARN HOW TO MANAGE AND PROVIDE FIRST AID FOR:

You'll also learn how to manage and provide first aid for: Allergic reactions (including anaphylaxis), asthma, cuts, bruises, burns (including chemical burns), seizures, strokes, diabetic emergencies, heatstroke, hypothermia, jellyfish and fish spine injuries, marine stings and bites (octopus, snake, spider), and more.
